Thank you Chief. Steve –thank you for your leadership and service, I certainly will do my best to live up to the high standard my predecessors have set. I want to thank each of you - my judicial colleagues for the honor of serving as the chair of the Ohio Judicial Conference – THE voice of Ohio's judges- it has even a more special meaning as we celebrate the 100th anniversary of the 19th Amendment to the Constitution.

I am proud of you all for the agile and creative ways Ohio's judiciary has responded to the Covid-19 pandemic. With ever changing rules, guidance, scientific theories and politics Ohio judges have rose to the challenge of resuming court operations to prevent the delay of justice to individuals and businesses. We as judges pressed on despite increasing the exposure of ourselves to Covid 19 in order to maintain the public's trust that justice would not be delayed nor denied.
