IT IS HEREBY ORDERED the Miamisburg Municipal Court's Violations Bureau shall accept a bond forfeiture in the amount of two hundred fifty dollars (\$250.00), which includes a fine amount of one hundred thirty dollars (\$130.00), plus court costs in the amount of one hundred twenty dollars (\$120.00), for all Minor Misdemeanor and Unclassified Misdemeanor offenses that would normally require a mandatory appearance.

This Order applies to all Minor Misdemeanor and Unclassified Misdemeanor offenses, including, but not limited to the following offenses: School Zone Violations, School Bus Violations, and Emergency Vehicle Violations.

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED This Order is effective immediately, beginning March 16, 2020, and shall remain in effect for sixty (60) days, through May 15, 2020.
