Legislative News: Two Week Review

- The OJC Jury Service Committee has created a document to aid in all the possible considerations required to convene a jury or conduct a jury trial. This is a work in progress and feedback is appreciated. It is available on the OJC website, which also contains other resources related to courts functioning during the COVID-19 pandemic, and a library of emergency orders.
- In In re A.W., 2020-Ohio-1457, the Ohio Supreme Court found that because a juvenile court loses **subject-matter jurisdiction over a child** when the child turns 21, a juvenile court's order invoking the adult portion of the (former) child's sentence that was not journalized until the day of child's 21st birthday is void, decided on 4.16.20.
- In In re N.M.P., 2020-Ohio-1458, the Ohio Supreme Court found that under RC 2151.414 (B)(1)(d), a children services agency may seek **permanent custody of a child** who has been in the temporary custody of the agency for 12 of the consecutive 22-month period preceding the filing of the motion, decided 4.16.20.
- In <u>State v. Jeffries</u>, 2020-Ohio-1539, the Ohio Supreme Court found that both consensual and nonconsensual sexual activity is barred from admission into evidence by **Ohio rape-shield law**, RC 2907.02 (D), 2907.05 (E), decided on 4.22.20.
