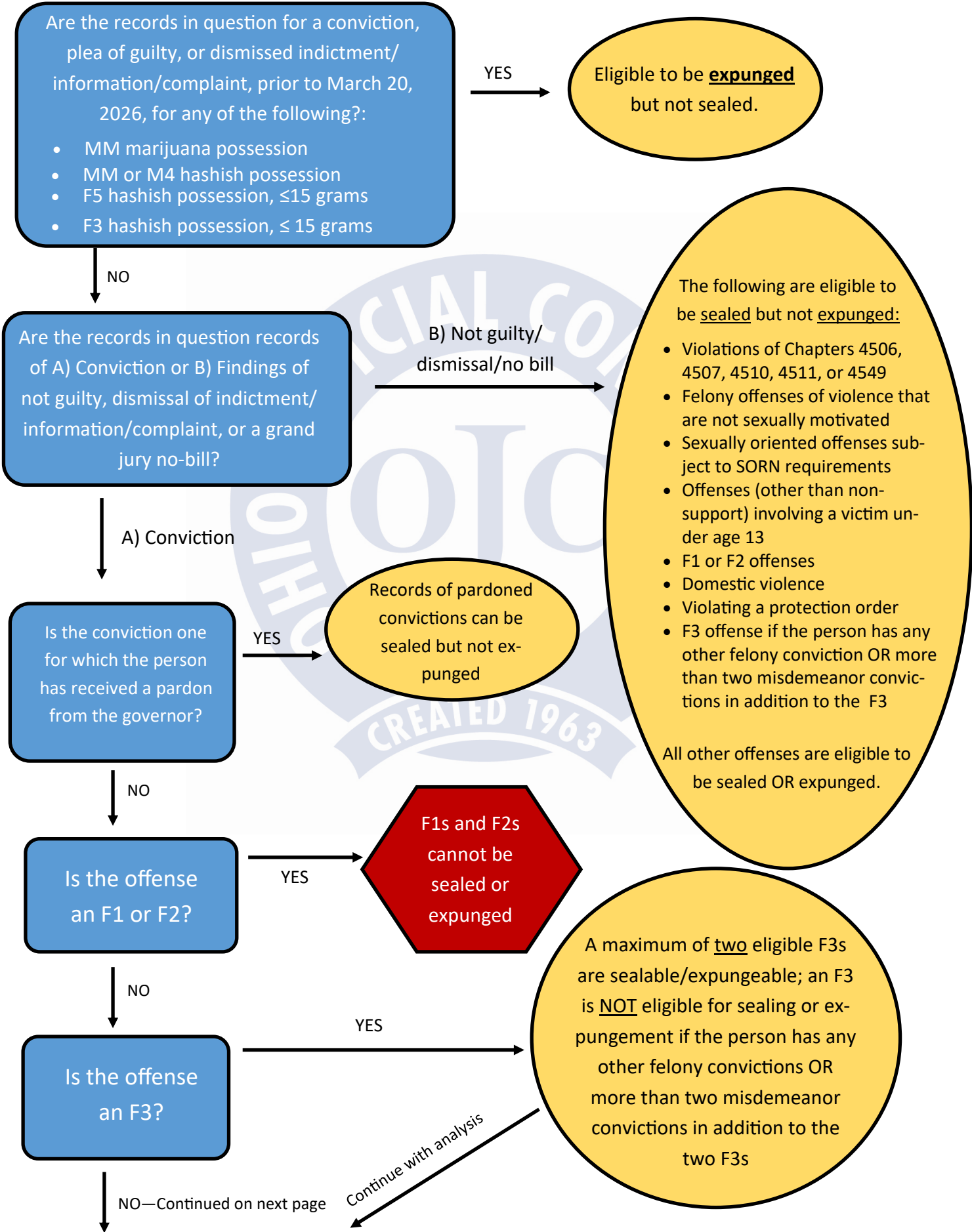


# Adult Record Sealing & Expungement Offense Eligibility



Is the offense a *felony* offense of violence\*?  
2903.01, 2903.02, 2903.03, 2903.04, 2903.11, 2903.12, 2903.13, 2903.15, 2903.18, 2903.21, 2903.211, 2903.22, 2903.34, 2905.01, 2905.11, 2905.32, 2907.02, 2907.03, 2907.05, 2909.02, 2909.03, 2909.24, 2911.01, 2911.02, 2911.11, 2911.12, 2917.01, 2917.02, 2917.03, 2917.31, 2919.22, 2919.25, 2921.03, 2921.04, 2921.34, 2923.161  
\*Note that "offense of violence" includes attempt/ conspiracy/complicity for the above offenses

Felony offenses of violence cannot be sealed or expunged

Is the offense an offense of domestic violence (2919.25)?

M1/M2 offenses of DV cannot be sealed or expunged

M3/M4 offenses of DV can be sealed but not expunged

Is the offense a sexually oriented offense\* subject to SORN?  
\*See R.C. 2950.01 (A)

Sexually oriented offenses subject to SORN are not eligible for sealing or expungement

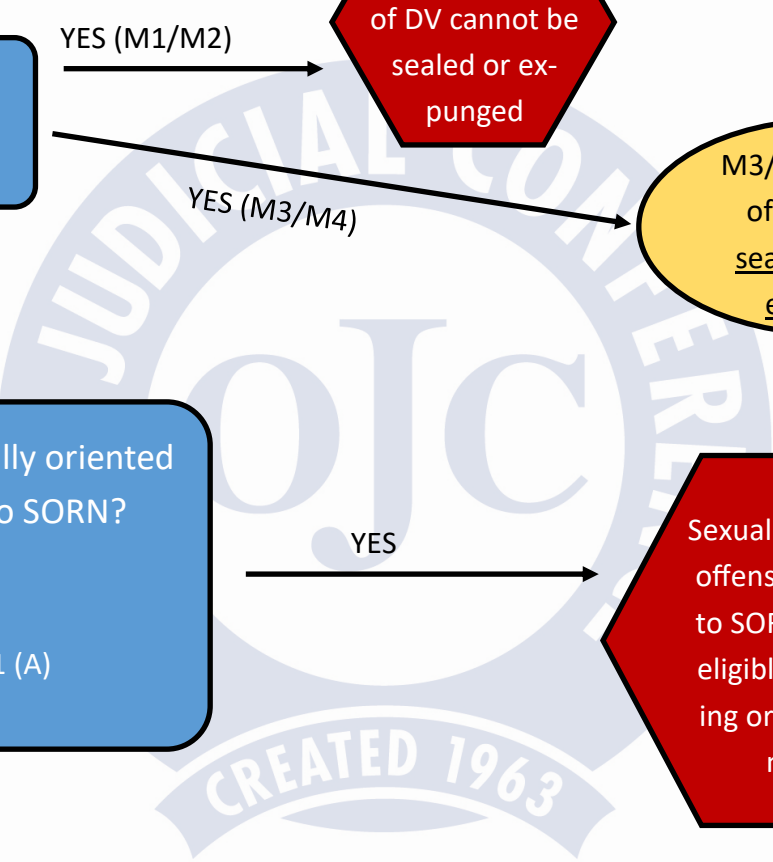
Does the offense have a victim under age 13?

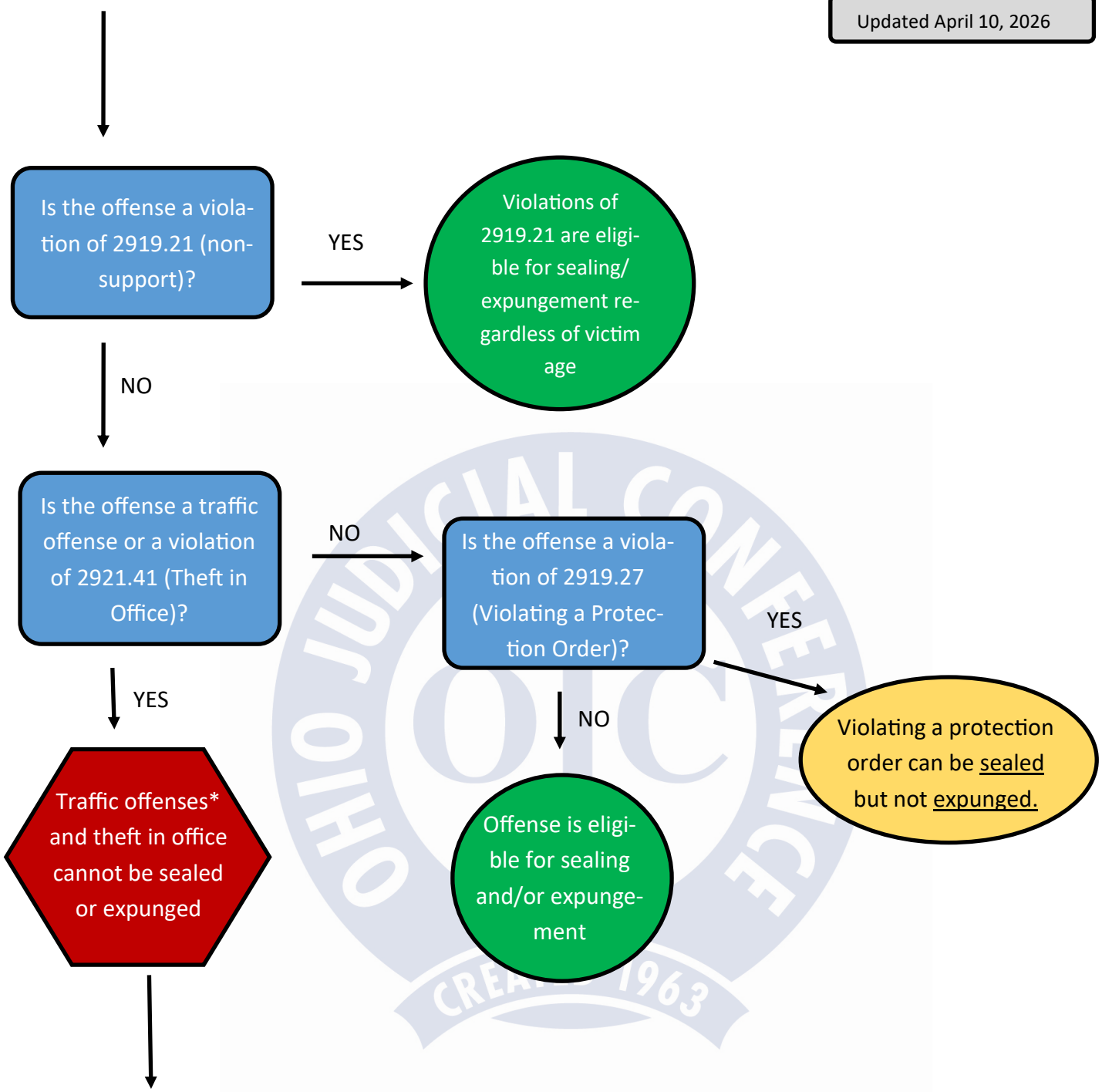
Is the offense a violation of 2919.21 (non-support)?

Violations of 2919.21 are eligible for sealing/expungement regardless of victim age

Offenses with victims <13 years old cannot be sealed or expunged

\*Note though that R.C. 2953.61 (B) permits the sealing or expunging of an entire record containing only ONE non-OVI traffic offense along with other eligible offenses that are all in connection with the same act.
